EXPERIENCED:

Rider is comfortable handling difficult horses in various environments/situations.

VERY EXPERIENCED:

Have previous experience training horses, or experience with handling green horses.

WANTED HORSE LEVEL

BEGINNER:

Horse that is calm and gentle, beginner/child could handle "bomb proof".

ADVANCED BEGINNER:

Horse is generally calm, but not good for new rider or small child.

INTERMEDIATE:

Horse occasionally tests rider and/or acts up (bucking, spooking).

EXPERIENCED:

Horse continually tests rider, acts up and/or has special needs.

Horse is hot/very sensitive/green or untrained.
